

## CHILL PROGRAM

*Completing Homework in a Learning Lab*, is a homework completion program that is available to any 5th -8th grade student living in or near the Eastown (Salvation Army) and River Haven Village communities.

The purpose of this program is to provide a supervised location for students to complete assignments, catch up on past due work, study for tests and receive extra help right in their own neighborhood. The Salvation Army provides a snack for both locations. Each CHILL location has a Coordinator and an assistant, we also have high school mentors. The CHILL staff communicates with teachers so that we are all working on the same goals with the students. Kids are rewarded for good behavior, grades and work completion.

Another important part of this program is community service. Students will be participating in several projects throughout the school year to help serve our community.

Eastown CHILL is held at the Salvation Army building, River Haven CHILL is held at the River Haven Clubhouse. CHILL runs **Monday-Thursday**. White Pines students attend from **3:00-4:00**. Transportation is provided.
