Dear Parents/Guardians,

Greetings future seventh grade parents! It is the time of year when we register your student for the 2018-2019 school year. Students will register for their elective class through StudentVue. Parents can also access this information through ParentVue. Please note that once a request is submitted, it cannot be changed by the student or parent. All course requests must be submitted by **Friday, February 23, 2018**.

Next year, students will be divided into teams taking the following core classes: English Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, one semester of Art, and one semester of technology. Seventh grade students may also be recommended for Algebra (worth one high school credit) in place of their 7th grade Math course. Students are recommended based on district criteria and a teacher recommendation. Each student will be notified of their placement at the end of the school year.

Seventh grade elective classes are:

Pick One

- Yearlong music class (band, choir, or orchestra)
- Yearlong physical education

We are excited to welcome our new 7th grade class. We are planning both parent and student events that will help during this transition period. Student Transition Day will be Friday, May 4th. Students will spend the morning at Lakeshore Middle School. Incoming 7th Grade Parent Night will be held **Tuesday, May 8th at 6:30 p.m.** More information will follow as we approach this event.

We are again planning our summertime “Give & Take” for your student to receive a schedule, team information, student pictures, Chromebook, tour the building and other important news for the 2018-2019 school year.
